- I. Welcome
 - A. Minutes from 9/7/22 were reviewed and approved
- II. Principal's report
 - A. 95 Phonics, a structure based literacy program, is in full swing for grades K-3.
 - B. Conferences will begin next week. Sign ups have been sent to families.
 - C. Wellness Wednesday is also in full swing for this school year.
- III. President's Report
 - A. Publishing Shop
 1. Publishing Shop was discussed to confirm how it would be best run this year. It was decided that teachers would sign up to bring students to the Publishing Shop to create books. Students may be brought in 4-5 at a time and if an entire class were to come, the cafeteria could serve as an overflow for students to work on books.
 - B. Past events
 1. Leed's Recap
 - a) Leed's was a very successful evening. Although PTO does not plan for Leed's to serve as a fundraiser, we did make \$1288 in tickets and cookies.
 - C. Upcoming Events
 1. Fall Fest / Silent Auction
 - a) Rain plans
 - (1) Fall Fest will go on with the exception of thunder and lightning being present. If Bounce House Ohio feels it is necessary to cancel, the event will be canceled. If necessary, we will ask for tent donations.
 - b) Location for Magic Nate
 - (1) Mrs. Brundrett will speak to Mrs. Schwartz about the location of Magic Nate. The stage in the Commons and the Teacher Lounge were discussed as possible locations. It would be ideal to have Magic Nate in an enclosed room to collect tickets to help with the cost of Magic Nate.
