

Wyandot Elementary PTO Meeting Minutes
November 4, 2021, 7:00 pm
Virtual Meeting via Zoom

- I. Principal's Report
 - A. Wellness Week was successful for both staff and students. Emphasis on the Zones of Regulation, mindfulness, and emotions.
 - B. Drug Mart and the Governor's Office will be assisting in holding vaccine clinics for 5-11 year olds through the schools. Vaccines are not mandatory. Dates, times, and location will be announced in the near future.
- II. President' Report
 - A. Fall Fest was a successful event, bringing in approximately \$3,000. Changes to the event (should it be held outside again) were discussed, and include less food if food trucks are present, heavier games to accommodate windy conditions, and the return of the 50/50 raffle and silent auction.
 - B. Walk-A-Thon will take place on 11/23/21. A Sign-Up Genius is being created and will be sent out to secure volunteers for the stations. Each grade will walk for a total of 30 minutes. Donations will begin to be collected on November 15 and may be made online, or by cash or check. Collection will end on November 23.
 - C. The Berwick orders need to be placed by November 11 at 1:00pm for pick up on the 12th.
 - D. PTO has sponsored 3 families with 2 children each for Welcome Warehouse's Adopt-A-Family. We are awaiting the lists and will put together a Sign-Up-Genius once those are received.
 - E. Kyle Sprouse has requested a grant for \$75.00 to purchase a new percolator for the staff. The grant was unanimously approved.
- III. Treasurer's Report
 - A. We currently have a balance of \$28,696.03 in total between 2 accounts. Leed's Farm earned \$1562, Spirit Wear earned \$433, and general fundraising has earned \$578. Fall Fest brought in \$3,047, which was significantly less than years past, but was a new event in a new format. We will plan to add a line in the budget next year for Wellness Week, which will be separate from other events and grants.
