I. Principal's Report

- A. The district had decided to remain in hybrid mode until January, with the goal of full return. Mrs. Schwartz is encouraging everyone to enroll in in-person learning or RLA prior to the November 9th deadline. Additional reminders will continue to be sent out. Movement of teachers and students will depend on final enrollment numbers.
- B. Staff participated in a Professional Development Day on November 3, focusing on inclusion and equity both in the district and at Wyandot. Emails will soon be sent to parents for those who are interested in providing input to the school and district on this topic. Wyandot teachers and staff are also continuing these conversations on a small group level.
