

Wyandot Elementary PTO Meeting Minutes

I. Principal's Report

- A. Enjoying a great start to the year without Covid Restrictions!
- B. Getting through assessments, the children have done wonderful with the assessments and it is showing a strong start to the year!

II. President's Report

- A. ROX - Wyandot PTO will continue to support this program for the 5th grade girls. The cost for this program has increased from \$75/girl last year to \$100/girl. Mrs. Brundrett has secured grants for 8 students and requested a grant from PTO to support an additional 10 students. The Board voted unanimously to approve this grant.

**The PTO voted after the meeting to support an additional 2 students. ROX will be supporting a total of 20 students this year. They will be selected via lottery.

B. Past Events

- 1. School supply sale - PTO profited \$435.71
 - a. School Kidz is unable to send the Twistables. The second grade team approved the option of School Kidz refunding the PTO for the amount of the Twistables and PTO will purchase any needed supplies.
- 2. Spirit wear sale - Final sales are \$864 which is double last year! We have bags left over that we will sell at Fall Fest and the following school year

C. Upcoming Events

- 1. Room parent and classroom volunteers - The sign ups are filling but there are still several spots to fill. PTO will be posting the sign up again as a reminder and include descriptions about the duties to help parents understand what it means to be a volunteer. PTO will support any classrooms who do not have a room parent. It was also decided that food and snacks will not be included in parties this year due to the number of food allergies in the classrooms.
- 2. Leeds farm - 9/23/22 - 6-8:15pm - The details for this fun night have been finalized and the tickets will be going on sale very soon! Everyone ages 3 and above needs a ticket for entry.
- 3. Fall Fest Updates - 10/23/22 1-5pm - All of the details are in the final stages of prep! We have 17 games and 3 inflatables. The eatery is back open and will be featuring pizza, drinks and fall treats. We are in talks with having an area to help celebrate the beginning of Diwali. There will also be a Silent Auction taking place prior to Fall Fest. We hope to have pick up of the Silent Auction items during Fall Fest.
- 4. Publishing room - The Eagle Publishing room has been cleaned out and organized for easy use this year! We will be setting up a sign up for the

teachers who want to utilize this room with their class to make books. The PTO will be assisting them with this process and is excited for what has been purchased to update the Publishing Room.

5. Author visit and Book Fair - Mr. Kelly is looking into an Author visit. More details to come. The library will be hosting Book Fairs in October and May.
 - A. The October Book Fair will be held during conferences (which are to remain online.) Mr. Kelly will have the book fair open for a few hours after school one day. PTO will not have an event in conjunction with this Book Fair.
 - B. The May Book Fair will take place during the first week of May. PTO is planning to host a family event during that time, maybe a breakfast.
