**B. Upcoming Events**

1. **Field Day** - Sign-Up Genius to be sent out and we are getting a lot of participation for this event!

- Because of the rising costs of school supplies, the PTO is not receiving as much profit from the sale, which should be factored into next year's budget.

C. **Volunteers for next school year** - Sign-Up Genius at the end of this year to try to fill in gaps! We are excited to allow more participation from volunteers next year. D. **Grant for PE/recess equipment** - Mr. Vosler submitted a grant to the PTO for a total of \$738.44 for new sporting equipment that would benefit all kids at the school. He is in need of these items. He would normally have the aid of the Box Tops collected at the school to help fund these types of purchases, however there has been a significant drop in Box Top collections with the introduction of the app.

The grant was approved unanimously by the PTO on April 7th for the full amount requested of \$738.44. On April 8th we approved an additional \$124.94 and \$64.48 for the appropriate taxes and shipping costs bringing the total of this grant approval to \$972.42.
