

Wyandot Elementary PTO Meeting Minutes
May 6, 2021, 7:00 pm

I. Principal's Report

- A. Currently in a holding pattern for the planning of next school year. Updates will be provided throughout the summer as health guidelines change. Both full-in and RLA students are doing very well this school year. Social/emotional scores for students in grades 3-5 are high. The district will continue to offer targeted learning programs throughout the summer for students. COSI on Wheels will be at Wyandot at the end of June with boxed lunches for students. Additional information will follow. All current staff will remain at Wyandot. A new clinic aide will be hired for next school year as the current clinic aide is furthering her education. The school is also in need of a crossing guard. The staff will meet with the new staff from the Central Office in the coming weeks.
- B. R.O.X. has been very successful this year, and Mrs. Brundrett would like to continue the program during the next school year.

II. President's Report

- A. Scholarships for Wyandot Alumni
 - 1. Three recipients were awarded a scholarship of \$500 each. One recipient is graduating from Jerome and the other two are graduating from Coffman.
- B. Rah Rah Spirit Wear
 - 1. Raised a total of \$220. Mrs. Schwartz said some of the staff had an issue with the sweatshirts, but Rah Rah was happy to work with them to correct the issue.
- C. Teacher Appreciation Week
 - 1. Gift cards to Target will be delivered to staff tomorrow.
- D. School Supply Sale
 - 1. Running through June 4.
- E. 5th graders
 - 1. T-shirts are being ordered through Dublin Business Association. Moving Up Ceremony will take place May 26, with a rain date of May 27. PTO will order balloons, as well as bundlets for this event. A car parade will take place on the 26th at 4:30.
- F. Grant for Mrs. Layel for the garden
 - 1. Grant for \$70.07 was approved to help eliminate the grubs that have infested the garden.
- G. Reading Room Books
 - 1. A total of \$2636 that was allocated for teacher grants remains unused. It was decided that \$2500 of this budgeted money will be used to purchase additional books for the reading rooms at Wyandot. The purchased books will be leveled books that reflect more diverse characters.
- H. Upcoming events for school year 2021-22

 - a) We will reach out to the chair of this committee to verify the deposit will be mailed to COSI.
2. Leeds
 - a) Scheduled for September 24, 2021. Due to the pandemic, we will not have a bake sale this year and will only offer food prepared by a restaurant that has been prepackaged.

 - a) It was decided that Winterfest will be held as an outdoor carnival, with a tentative date of October 16th. Additional details to follow. Walk-A-Thon will be held in November, with a focus on movement the 2 days prior to Thanksgiving break.
