PTO Cabinet Meeting Minute  
Thursday, February 6, 2020, 7:00 pm

- I. Welcome to the PTO Co-Presidents at Bailey Elementary, Emily Marshall and Christa Aylward - Christa Aylward graciously attended the PTO meeting to discuss the PTO at Bailey Elementary and answered any questions families being redistricted to Bailey may have had. Bailey has two volunteers in each PTO Board position and families interested in holding such a position should visit [mybaileyppto.com](http://mybaileyppto.com) for information. A transition website is being set up by the district with all upcoming events at the elementary schools listed. The website should be up and running by the end of February.
  
- II. Principal's Report - Be Well will be held the morning of February 29 at Emerald Campus. Registration for this event is open.

Mrs. Schwartz has been meeting with the principal at Bailey to discuss the upcoming transition for students being redistricted to Bailey. On April 8, 2020, elementary schools will be hosting a Family Welcome Night. Families should attend at the school they will be attending next school year. Those attending Hopwell and Abraham Depp will attend this event at one of the high schools on April 15, 2020. Changes to staff are currently underway throughout all elementary schools. All open positions will be posted internally on 2/7/20.

Conferences are taking place during the next two weeks.

- III. President's Report
  - A. Minutes from 1/9/20 meeting were approved.
  - B. Welcome to the new Treasurers - Dina Messina and Elaine Borgerding have officially transitioned into the treasurer positions.
  - C. Winterfest Update
    1. Updated locations for various events/activities - The library will not be able to be used during Winterfest due to the Book Fair. Prize Palace will be relocated to the Teacher's Lounge. The Bollywood Dancers will be moved to the Innovation Lab and Magic Nate will be moved to the Music Room. Several games will be cut to make room for sponsors and snacks in the hallways.
    2. All student volunteer positions have been filled. We still are in need of adults for ticket sales, Tootsie Roll Raffle, and Student Raffle.
    3. Ticket sale contest to run 2/10 - 2/25 - bulletin board to track each class - It was decided that the contest will take place from 2/10 - 2/25. Online ticket sales will start this weekend and paper forms will be copied and will go home on 2/9.
    4. Silent auction to take place on Bidding Owl prior to event - Amber is working getting the approximately 35 items onto the website. We will plan to have a pick up day for those who purchase items. Dates and times to be determined. The auction will be kept open through the end of

Winterfest so that people have an opportunity to bid during the event.  
Signs will be made up to advertise this.

- D. Survey results - 92% of respondents were happy with the number of events held by the PTO. The top three rated events were Leeds (1st), Winterfest/Pow Wow (2nd), and Donuts With Dad/Mornings With Mom (3rd). Combining DWD and MWM into one event for next year was discussed. Parents prefer email and paper flyers as the main forms of communication, followed by Facebook posts. Some new ideas for events next year included Bingo/game night, a larger gathering at Meet the Teacher (Mrs. Schwartz feels this will be difficult the day before school starts, but we can discuss other options for this), family dance, and Supergames for Field Day.
  - E. Groveport Collection - We collected multiple gift cards and a large box of notebooks, folders, and other supplies. Erin Wolf kindly dropped these items off at Groveport Elementary.
- IV. Treasurer's Report - No significant changes to the budget
- V. Committee Reports
- A. Box Top Collection Contest - 5,369 clipped Box Tops were collected for the month of January. 43% of all scanned digital Box Tops occurred during the month of January.
  - B. Eagle Publishing - Many classes are utilizing Eagle Publishing this year. Rebecca Ferro needed to purchase more supplies for the shop. The materials cost a total of \$98.94, putting Eagle Publishing over budget this year by \$88.86. A vote decided that Rebecca should be reimbursed for this expense. Materials should last through next school year.
  - C. Field Day - Mr. Vosler had inquired about using Supergames for Field Day this year. Supergames has availability on May 12th. The budget for Field Day was \$2500, however, Supergames charges \$3500 for 15 stations and staff. Those present voted to increase the Field Day budget by \$1000 so that Supergames can be used for Field Day this year. Mr. Vosler will be notified of this change and Dina will send a check to Supergames for the deposit.
  - D. COSI On Wheels for 2020-2021 school year - Marissa Schoening will be reserving COSI on Wheels for the 2020-2021 school year. It was agreed that "Uncovering the Universe" would be the topic covered and Mrs. Schwartz requested 11/23 and 11/24/20 as her first choice dates for this event, with any day in December being her second choice.
  - E. Jason's Deli Night - April 9th 5:00 - 9:00 pm and Chipotle Night - May 4th 4:00 - 8:00 pm. Chick-Fil-A Family Night to take place in March and an event at Get Air will take place in April. Amber is speaking with both companies.
