

Wyandot Elementary PTO Meeting Minutes  
Thursday, September 9, 2021  
Held virtually at 7:00 pm via Zoom

- I. Welcome and Introductions
- II. Principal's Report
  - A. Mrs. Schwartz reported the school year is off to a great start! Assessments are ongoing and data is looking great so far. There is a focus on "Wyandot Why" and staff at Wyandot will be reaching out to parents to determine their "Why". The end of September will bring "Wellness Wednesdays", which will focus on the Social-Emotional learning of students, in 30 minute lessons each Wednesday. On September 10, Wyandot will thank first responders with thank you cards and breakfast. Students are encouraged to wear red, white, and blue, and celebrate our first responders.
- III. Ruling Our eXperiences (ROX) presented by Mrs. Brundrett
  - A. ROX is a 20 week curriculum for 5th grade girls to teach girls to control their own relationships, experiences, and decisions. The curriculum does continue into middle school. Mrs. Brundrett helped start the program last school year, and it was a great success. This year, all Dublin City Schools have received a grant to help support the cost of the program (\$75/girl). Mrs. Brundrett may request help with funding those who are chosen for the program in the future, but is unsure if funds are needed at this time. The PTO has set aside \$1500 (equal to funding provided last year for the program) should she need financial assistance in the future.

  - A. Spirit Wear should be available for those who ordered in 2-3 weeks. We are awaiting the cost of the final order placed, which should be available prior to the October 7th meeting.

    1. Online sales and changes to food sales at event
      - a) We have currently sold 122 tickets as of 9/9/21. Sales will continue online until 9/22 and then be sold in person at the event. Chick-Fil-A will provide meals for \$8.00 and under and Nothing Bundt Cakes bundlets will be sold for \$5.00 each.
  - B. Fall Fest
    1. To be held outside behind Wyandot on Saturday, October 16, 2021 from 4:00-8:00 pm

  - 2. Tickets online
    - a) Forms to go out at the end of September. A ticket contest will be held the first 2 weeks in October.
  - 3. Supergames
    - a) Providing 2 open air obstacle courses, as well as carnival games.
  - 4. Changes to food sales/eatery
    - a) Taco Truck and Daawat Bistro will be providing food for this event. We will be selling popcorn, bundlets, and apple fritters (all packaged prior to the event), as well as drinks.
  - 5. Baskets, Tootsie Roll Raffles, Time with Teachers updates
    - a) Items for the class baskets are being collected in the classrooms and will be collected and put together by the room parent coordinators, Allison Saucedo and Christina Simone. The Tootsie Roll Raffle is now the Lollipop Raffle, and will run similarly to the Tootsie Roll Raffle. Time With Teachers has been suspended until next year. All raffles will take place at the event and will not occur during lunch this year.
  - 6. Is there a criterion that could be met where the event would need to be canceled?
    - a) With the event being outdoors and spread throughout the back of the school, the event should be able to take place as planned. Indoor restrooms will need to be used. Mrs. Schwartz has requested we have a bathroom monitor to limit the number of people entering the building at one time, and encourage mask use while inside.
- C. Walk-A-Thon
- 1. Held November 22 and 23
    - a) Unsure as to what this will look like at this time. We will revisit Walk-A-Thon plans in the future.
- D. Conferences
- 1. Taking place virtually 10/13 and 10/21. Lucy Andrews has kindly offered to secure meals for the staff this year. Meals do not have to be individually boxed this year.

VI. Treasurer’s Report

- A. We currently have a balance of \$21,775.02. We are awaiting checks from School Kidz for the school supply sale. Included in that amount should be a refund for Twistable crayons, which needed to be purchased by PTO for grade 2 because they could not be supplied by School Kidz due to pandemic related issues. Six staff members have utilized the \$100 provided to them at the beginning of the year.
