

Wyandot Elementary  
PTO Meeting Minutes  
Thursday October 3, 2019 9:30 a.m.

- I. Welcome - Minutes from 9/5/19 meeting were approved
- II. Principal's Report
  - A. Redistricting Information - The main points that were discussed are as follows:
    - 1. Principals at both Bailey Elementary and Wyandot will be working together to help students from Wyandot transition to Bailey. PTO will gladly assist where needed. There is focus on the social/emotional concerns of the students. Peers will be grouped so that Wyandot student will have another Wyandot student in his/her new classroom next year. Bailey will also be taking in around 250 new students next year from different schools. Once redistricting is complete, it will be discussed with students at school.
    - 2. Loss of staff at schools was discussed. The district is trying to balance the staff at all schools. Wyandot will lose some staff through the movement of students, as staff will need to be relocated to where it is needed.
    - 3. A decision has not been made regarding students in 5th and 8th grade or their siblings.
    - 4. Parents were encouraged to reach out with any questions/concerns via the public meetings scheduled for next week (10/7, 10/8, 10/10) or through the district email ([info@dublinschools.net](mailto:info@dublinschools.net)). It was expressed that Dr. Hoadley was not able to listen to "move them not me" complaints.
- III. Treasurer's Report
  - A. Leed's
    - 1. Leed's was a very successful event, bringing in \$2,620.47.
  - B. Budget without Walkathon income
    - 1. Three budget items (Wyandot Wear, Leed's, and the school supply sale) have brought in more money than previously budgeted. Money from the PTO savings account will be moved to help cover all planned PTO events and grants, which in turn will draw down the large balance of the account as previously discussed.

  - A. Trivia Night (10/18/19 from 5:30-7:00 pm)
    - 1. Book Fair - One raffle ticket will be handed out for every book sold at the Book Fair this evening.
  - B. Walk to Stomp Out Cancer (11/1/19)
    - 1. Many events and physical activities are planned for both the morning and afternoon. Afternoon events include a house walk from 1:00-3:15 pm with different physical activity stations. Buddies will walk with the morning kindergarten classes, so that they may be able to participate in the walk.

Shoelaces will be sold for \$5.00/pair, with all profits being donated to Pavan's family. If the shoelaces are in, the PTO would like to sell them at Trivia Night. The week of the event, Karrer Middle School will be donating all profits from snacks sold to Pavan's family. Videos will be sent to Pavan to document the day.
